

A CHRISTMAS SHEPHERD CRAFT – *fast and easy...and delicious!*



You don't need a lot of supplies for this craft!

A roll made from construction paper (or cover a toilet paper roll!)

A circle of white paper (draw a nice face on it)

A pipe cleaner – any colour will do.

A square of tissue paper – any colour.

A bit of string or twine

A candy cane (*that's the delicious part!*)

Here's what you do...

Make 2 small holes on either side of the roll, and feed the pipe cleaner through it. Curl both ends of the pipe cleaner to be the shepherd's hands.

Make a face on your circle of white paper and glue it about 1/3 of the way down the roll.

Put the square of tissue paper over the top of the roll, and tie it on with your string/twine.

Fold one of the shepherd's arms around the candy cane, so that it looks like he's holding a shepherd's hook.

You can always put some "googly eyes" on cotton balls for sheep, if you like.

*Maybe once the shepherd has put away his sheep for the night,
you can "borrow" his hook as a treat!*
